Personal information for joint use Name, date of birth, gender, occupation, nationality, address, telephone number, email address, vehicle model, vehicle registration number, driver’s license information, credit card information (hereinafter, this includes the cardholder name, card number, expiration date, and usage history), camera images (taken by onboard cameras, such as dash cams, cameras installed in parking facilities), service usage history, and other items necessary to achieve the purposes of use.</li> <li>2. Acquisition method Verbal communication (including telephones), web forms, contracts, application forms, questionnaires, and other written communication methods (including records created through electromagnetic or other means) User information also will be acquired and collected through the relevant joint user when the Renter or the Driver uses a service provided by a joint user.</li> </ol> <p>9.
