Comparison of New vs. Old Terms and Conditions (revised October 1, 2026)

Article 21	<u>4. The due diligence set forth in Paragraph 1 shall apply not only to the Renter’s own actions but also to the actions of the Driver or passengers.</u>	(Added)
Article 22 1.	<u>(5) Driving the Rental Car into areas where it is foreseeable that the Rental Car will be defaced or damaged beyond normal wear and tear, including such offroad areas as beaches, riversides, or forests, or safari parks where animals may come into contact with the car.</u>	(Added)
Article 22 1.	<u>(14) Using items provided in the Rental Car for purposes other than those approved by the Company, or interfering with the use of them without the prior consent of the Company.</u>	(Added)
Article 37	<u>3. The Company may disclose information recorded by In-vehicle Equipment and dashcam footage that falls under Article 38 to the nonlife insurance companies under contract with the PARK24 GROUP in any of the following cases. In addition, with respect to such disclosure of information, the Company may receive feedback of the results of analysis and evaluation, and other similar information from such nonlife insurance company.</u> <u>(1) When it is for improvement in the quality of goods and services to be provided to the Renter and the Driver</u> <u>(2) When the Company considers it necessary for an analysis of an accident involving the Rental Car</u> <u>(3) When the Company considers it necessary for safety measures for the Rental Car</u>	(Added)
Article 42 2.	<u>(3) When the Company provides Automobile Manufacturers, as well as nonlife insurance companies under contract with the PARK24 GROUP and their affiliated companies with such information for such safety management initiatives as accident analysis, improvement of services, and other purposes. In addition, when the Company receives the results of the analysis or other information from these recipients of information to achieve the purpose of this item.</u>	(Added)

Article 43	<p><u>Article 43: Handling of information obtained from video recorders or cameras installed in parking lots</u></p> <p><u>With respect to license plate numbers, vehicle images, and other relevant information (hereinafter “Vehicle Information”) obtained from video recorders or cameras installed in parking lots by TIMES24 Co. Ltd., its business partners, owners of parking lots, or other parties, the Company may receive Vehicle Information from such obtainers of information and use such information in conjunction with the information on the Renter and the Driver possessed by the Company or provide third parties (such as parties involved in accidents or other trouble, insurance companies, or franchisees) with such information for any of the following purposes. In such case, the Company will handle such information in accordance with the provisions of each paragraph of Article 36.</u></p> <p><u>(1) To identify and resolve accidents, trouble, or other issues involving the Service and the Rental Car</u></p> <p><u>(2) To identify violations of these Terms and Conditions (such as misconduct or failure to report an accident)</u></p> <p><u>(3) To grasp the operation status such as incorrect return location (incorrect parking)</u></p> <p><u>(4) Otherwise to conduct an investigation and analysis related to safety management or maintenance of service quality</u></p>	(Added)
