Handling of personal information

[3] Handling of personal information, including credit card information

The purposes for which Company acquires personal information, including credit card information (card name, number, and expiration date) from our customers (hereinafter referred to as "Credit Card Information"), as well as the name of the company that acquires Credit Card Information, information recipients, and retention period, are as follows.

[4] Provision to third parties

The Company will not provide the acquired personal information to any third parties, excluding the following cases:

- (1) When consent is obtained from the subject person
- (2) When provision is made in accordance with a law or regulation
- (3) When it is necessary for the protection of human life, physical well-being, or property, and it is difficult to obtain consent from the subject person
- (4) When it is particularly necessary for the improvement of public health or promotion of sound development of children, and it is difficult to obtain consent from the subject person
- (5) When it is necessary to cooperate with the execution of statutory duties by a government agency, local government agency, or an entity to which such duties are contracted, and obtaining consent from the subject person may hinder the execution of the relevant duties
- (6) When subcontracting to a third party within the extent necessary for the achievement of the purpose of use
- (7) When succeeding the business due to a corporate merger or other reason
- (8) In the case of joint use in [2] above

[5] Contracting

The Company may, after taking appropriate protection measures, subcontract with PARK24 GROUP companies (<u>http://www.park24.co.jp/company/group.html</u>; excluding overseas companies) or other third parties for the handling of personal information provided by or acquired from our customers within the purpose of use set forth in [1] above. When subcontracting the handling of personal information, the Company will select appropriate subcontractors and implement the measures that are necessary and appropriate for supervision.

[6] Security management measures

The measures taken for security management are as follows:

- Formulation of a basic policy The Company has formulated the Privacy Policy and management system that conform to the JIS standards (JIS Q 15001), and in accordance with the policy and management system, the Company is striving to properly protect and manage personal information.
- 2. Establishment of rules concerning the handling of personal data Including the basic policy for the protection of personal information, the Company has established personal information handling methods for each phase, including acquisition, use, provision, and disposal, as well as rules for the persons in charge and their duties, and the Company revises these on a regular basis.

3. Organizational security management measures

In addition to appointing a Chief Privacy Officer as the person responsible and authorized for the execution and operation of the personal information protection management system, a Personal Information Protection Auditor who is responsible for personal information audits, and an Information System Officer who is responsible for information system management have also been appointed. Moreover, a Personal Information Protection Committee has been established within the Company for formulating measures and holding discussions in relation to the protection of personal information for the entire group. The Company has established a system for promptly reporting a fact or sign of a violation of a law or handling rules to the Chief Privacy Officer, and proper responses will be taken following discussion by the Personal Information Protection Committee. In addition, self-inspections of the work duties are conducted biannually, and personal information audits are conducted by the Compliance Division once each year.

- 4. Human security control measures The Company conducts regular training and broadly informs confidentiality related matters by incorporating them in the Work Rules and other rules.
- 5. Physical security control measures In order to prevent the theft or loss of the devices, electronic media, and documents used for handling personal data, information management rules for the protection of personal information have been set forth, and proper management is conducted. Also, the deletion of personal data and disposal of the devices and electronic media are done in a non-recoverable manner, and the deletion or disposal of the information is recorded.
- 6. Technical security control measures

The Company restricts access to systems that handle personal data and identifies and authenticates system users. Also, a framework for protecting the systems from unauthorized external access has been implemented, and an access log is acquired and analyzed.

7. Grasp of the external environment The Company does not handle personal data outside of Japan.

[7] Request for disclosure

Regarding personal information provided to or acquired by the Company, it is possible to request notification of the purpose of use, disclosure, correction, addition or deletion, suspension of use, deletion, or suspension of provision to third parties (hereinafter referred to as "Disclosure").

[8] Voluntary provision of personal information

The provision of personal information requested by the Company is voluntary. In case personal information is not provided by the customer, all or part of the services offered by the Company may not be available for use.

Please note that the Company may record telephone conversations for the purpose of accurately grasping and responding to customer feedback and requests and improving future services.
